### CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

All competitors must register with Golf Canada prior to the start of the Championship. Players that do not register may be subject to DISQUALIFICATION.

### OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUND

All players are entitled to a practice round at Osoyoos Golf Club on Saturday, August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Starting May 1<sup>st</sup>, please call 250-495-7003 to book a practice round. Tee times should be scheduled no later than 1:00 p.m. Additional practice rounds may be available in the weeks preceding the championship at the discretion of the host club. Competitors are entitled to only one complimentary practice round.

### PROVINCIAL TEAM PHOTOGRAPHS

Official Provincial Team photos will be taken promptly at 5:30 p.m. Saturday, August 17<sup>th</sup> prior to the player meeting and reception.

### PLAYER MEETING

All competitors **should** attend the player meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 17<sup>th</sup> at Osoyoos Golf Club. The Golf Canada Tournament Chair and Rules Chair will address important tournament information including local rules, pace of play policy, and code of conduct. This is also an opportunity for competitors to ask questions regarding the championship. Dress for the player meeting is golf attire.

### PLAYER RECEPTION

All competitors are invited to the Player Reception on Saturday, August 17<sup>th</sup>, at Osoyoos Golf Club. The reception will begin immediately after the player meeting at approximately 6:30 p.m. Dress for the reception is golf attire.

### STARTING TIMES

Starting times for the first and second rounds will be made available at registration and in the Golf Shop on Saturday, August 17<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. Final round starting times will be available in the evening preceding play at approximately 8:30 p.m. online at [www.golfcanada.ca/championships](http://www.golfcanada.ca/championships) and in the Golf Shop.

## PLAYER SHUTTLES

A shuttle service organized by the host club committee will be running a loop for **host hotels 1-3 ONLY** to/from the golf course throughout the championship. Shuttles will be departing each location approximately every 30 minutes.

## CADDIES

Starting May 1<sup>st</sup>, participants will be able to request caddies on a first-come, first-serve basis. If you are interested in reserving a caddie, please contact TBD.

The cost of a caddie is a **minimum** of \$40 per round. Once a caddie is assigned, the player should make their own scheduling arrangements with their caddie for the championship.

## MOTORIZED CARTS

Automotive transport is permitted at any stage of the championship for SENIOR COMPETITORS ONLY. There will be a maximum of two carts per group for players and caddies only. Caddies are not guaranteed a ride. Spectators, including spouses, are encouraged to attend the championship, but are not permitted to use automotive transportation at any time. Please view motorized transportation policy for details.

**Please note:** Senior competitors who choose to take motorized transportation during championship rounds are not eligible to compete in the Mid-Amateur and Mid-Master Division. Players wishing to compete in the Mid-Amateur and Mid-Master Divisions are allowed to take motorized transportation on the **PRACTICE ROUND ONLY**.

## ANTI-DOPING POLICY

Participants at Golf Canada championships must be aware that doping control tests may be conducted by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) on a random basis in accordance with the Canadian Anti-Doping Program. To avoid an inadvertent positive test and the consequences of an anti-doping rule violation, athletes are encouraged to read through the Golf Canada anti-doping policy. ## CODE OF CONDUCT & DRESS CODE

The Golf Canada Code of Conduct and Dress Code are in effect during the entire Championship. Violations will be dealt with based on the severity of the misconduct. ## NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you find you cannot compete in the championship, you must officially withdraw from the event by contacting Golf Canada's amateur championships department at 1-800-263-0009 ext. 322. Entry fees will not be refunded after the application deadline without a medical certificate. Entry fees will be refunded, less a \$50 administrative fee, if Golf Canada is notified of a player's intention to withdraw prior to the application deadline. If you do not officially withdraw, you may be subject to **DISQUALIFICATION** from future Golf Canada and provincial competitions.
