OGC – Tuesday Men's League – 2025

#### **General Information**

### Goals:

- Develop venues and weekly events that are fun for the participants, yet have a competitive feel to the round. Create an atmosphere of "relaxed golf" by establishing more team related contests with monthly scrambles and weekly "luck-of-the-draw", 2-man team contests.
- Attempt to increase the number of potential weekly winners by reducing the weekly individual prize fund and placing more emphasis on team results.
- Continue with skill events such as KP's, double deuce pot and gross/ net individual awards and reward league participants for their weekly support.
- Work towards creating a self-managed league that will be less taxing for both the Pro Shop Staff and the Members League Committee.

## Fees:

- \$20 one-time annual League Membership/Registration Fee
- \$25 weekly golf fee (incl. \$20 prize fund, one \$5 50/50 ticket)

## **Golf Formats:**

- 18 holes of golf, individual play (except on special play days designated for scrambles), rotate each week between Stableford and Individual Gross /Net Stroke Play. 5-somes allowed and tee times will be allocated as per previous years. 2,3 or 4 man scrambles will be scheduled for one Tuesday each month.

## Tee Boxes to be used for all players:

All golfers will play off tee boxes specific to the Men's League. Park Meadows – White Tee Boxes, Desert Gold – Silver Tee Boxes. For Scrambles and other Men's League special events, Tee Boxes specific to the venue will be announced.

### Weekly Skill Contests:

The field will be divided equally into three (3) flights each week, based on handicaps.

Payouts to consist of 2-Low Gross, 2-Low Net in each flight.

KP's awarded on three (3) Par 3's each week. The first three par 3's played will be contested by the A,B,C flights.

18<sup>th</sup> Hole is designated as Long Putt Contest for all golfers.

### 2- Man Lucky Partner Draw:

Random draw each week for partners. The combined total of the two net scores will designate the winning teams.

## **Optional Double Deuce Pot:**

The double deuce pot will be offered again this year. Participation is optional and winners must score two (2) deuces (gross) on any of the holes on the front 9 of the round played. The pot will build until such time as a winner is declared.

## **Pro Shop Card Draw:**

An optional card draw will be held each week. Individual playing cards will sold from a deck of 52 for \$5.00 each. A winner will be drawn each week regardless of the number of cards sold. Proceeds will be go towards a Pro Shop prize valued to the amount of cards sold that week.

# Weekly Participation Points:

Players will receive one (1) point for each round played during the league season. The points will be accumulated and at the **special increased prize table days**, one ticket for prizes will be given out for each round played. As a bonus, each golfer eating in the Clubhouse after their round will be given one extra increased prize table ticket.

The special prize table days will be held; one play day at the end of June and the second one the end of August. Both days are scheduled as shotgun starts, so all golfers will be in the Clubhouse for post round activities.

### Hole-in-Ones:

The Men's League will sponsor a \$100 bar tab for each Hole in One scored during the 2025 League season. Said bar tab must be used up on the day of the Hole in One. Funds provided by the sale of 50/50's.

## League Handicaps:

The League use Golf Canada as the Official handicap system for tabulating scoring results.

### **Guest Rates**:

Guests of Members playing on any League Play Day will be charged the reduced rate of \$80 plus tax. Said rate will include power cart and range balls. Guests may participate in the weekly prizes by paying the \$25 league play day fee BUT they must have a current and verifiable Golf Canada handicap. Guests without a handicap will not participate in the prizes.

## Rules of Play:

Unless otherwise notified, all League play will be governed by Golf Canada Rules of Golf. Special playing conditions may dictate that local rules could be adopted as required. (winter rules, ground under repair, course damage or construction, etc.)

<u>ALL</u> putts must be holed out. No gimmies allowed.

## Scoring:

Men's League Committee and Pro Shop Management have made the use of Golf Genius mandatory for scoring league play this year. Adopting Golf Genius assists the Pro Shop with tabulating the results more effectively and provides live scoring during and after the round.

### Allocation of the Weekly Prize Fund and Projected Revenues:

Draw prize, 50/50, door prize and skill prize winners are not required to be in attendance after the round. All golfers contribute the same amount of money each week in the prize fund and placing conditions should not be a factor in declaring who wins a prize.

The Pro Shop will email the weekly results on the Wednesday following Men's Night. Exception to the above would be the scramble play days where post round prizes would be announced and distributed by Pro Shop Staff after the round.

A portion of the proceeds from the sale of 50/50 tickets will be used for funding a \$100 bar credit for any "hole-in-one" scored during the Men's League Play Days.

## Prizes

18 Holes individual play- 16 total prizes awarded each week

3 Flights - 12 prizes awarded

2 Low Gross Winners in each flight – Sleeve of balls each

2 Low Net Winners in each flight – Sleeve of balls each

(1<sup>st</sup> wins Pro V's, 2<sup>nd</sup> wins Callaway)

KP's 3 prizes awarded

3 winners – Sleeve of balls each (Calloway Balls)

Long Putt 1 winner – Prize supplied by Spirit Ridge

# Lucky Partner Draw:

1 <sup>st</sup> Place	\$200	\$100 each
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	\$150	\$ 75 each
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place	\$100	\$ 50 each
4 <sup>th</sup> Place	\$ 50	\$ 25 each

#### Door Prizes:

A number of door prizes will be awarded based on a percentage of the amount of weekly fees received for the play day.
